

## Parent & Student Reminders - from the Dean's Office

Welcome to a new school year. The Dean's office has a few friendly reminders to help you out as the school year gets started.

**CP otherwise known as "Contact Period"** is considered a part of the school day. CP starts at 7:55am. If you are not in CP and had planned to participate in an after school activity or athletic team, you will not be allowed to practice or compete for that day. Make sure you are on time, and in uniform for CP everyday.

As the fall swings into full force, we need to remember that we are in fall dress standards for the first quarter. (Page 21) *School attire will be neat, clean and properly worn. This includes tucking in the shirt, buttoning down the collar, leaving no more than two buttons undone on the Oxford shirt, wearing pants from the waist, and not hemming the skirt too short or rolling the waistband. Skirt hems must be no more than 3 inches above the knee.*

(Page 21) *Hair must be neatly groomed and not cover the student's eyes. No extreme hair styles, including dreadlocks or mohawks, no unnatural coloring, no scarves or athletic headbands.*

(Page 21) ***Students who are not in compliance with the uniform standard will not be allowed to attend class until the problem is corrected and may receive disciplinary consequences.***

This may mean we have to send your child home to correct the problem. So please help us to be proactive and make sure your child is in uniform before they leave the house.

There is no gum chewing on campus. Students will be asked to spit out their gum and they will be written up and charged a \$5 gum fine. Chewing gum leads to a sticky situation!

(15) The use of cell phones is **not permitted** during the school day, **anywhere** in the building. Headphones, personal listening devices, electronic games and other "toys" may be used only in the cafeteria and on the beach and will be confiscated if used elsewhere. **Confiscated items, including cell phones, must be collected from the dean's office by a parent or guardian. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

**Student Parking!!!** Remember to always park in your spot assigned. If another car is in your spot it is best to park in free parking, and write it on the clipboard in the Dean's office, so not to take another persons spot. **This year if you get three or more tickets your parking permit may be revoked.**

When picking up your student after school, we advise you to designate a location **AWAY** from the congestion on 11th East. If you must pick up there, please line up next to the curb, but **NOT** in the bus lane which is adjacent to the south front doors. There is room on the street for a second line of cars if you pull in very close to the first. There is NOT room for a third line. If there is not room to pull out of what should be the moving lane of traffic, DO NOT STOP to pick up your child. Go around the block and try again. **Please drive slowly and cautiously when students are present.** Students, remember you are not allowed to pick up other students in the front of school. Please either have your carpool walk up with you to your car, or designate a location away from the congestion on 11th East.
